FIRST CONDITIONAL AND FUTURE TIME CLAUSES

We use first conditional sentences to talk about a possible future situation and its consequence.

We use the present tense (NOT the future) after **if** in first conditional sentences. (NOT If you'll work hard, you'll pass all your exams.)

The boss won't be very happy if we're late for the meeting.

We can also use an **imperative** instead of the **will clause**:

• Come and see us next week if you have time.

We can use unless instead of if +not in conditional sentences:

- She won't get into college unless she gets good grades / if she doesn't get good grades.
- I won't go unless you go, too.

Use the present tense (NOT the future) after when, as soon as, until, before, and after to talk about the future.

- As soon as you get your test scores, call me.
- We'll have dinner when your father gets home.
- I won't go to bed until you come home.
- I'll have a quick lunch before I leave.
- After I graduate from college, I'll probably take a year off and travel.
